- 1**  **Hardys 'The Riddle' Chardonnay-Semillon, £13.75**  
**SE Australia** 250ml Glass **£4.75**  
**Australia 13%** 175ml Glass **£3.50**

*A popular blend, combining a soft creamy texture with lime flavours and subtle oak characters that deliver a crisp dry white wine.*

- 2**  **Pinot Grigio Provincia di Pavia, £13.75**  
**Collezione Marchesini** 250ml Glass **£4.75**  
**Italy 12%** 175ml Glass **£3.50**

*Lovely buttery style with typical pear fruit. Grapes are fermented in stainless steel tanks with a long fermentation to enhance the rich style.*

**Riesling-Gewürztraminer,** 250ml Glass **£4.75**

**Australia 13%**

*Two classic aromatic grape varieties. Laden with lychees, a ripe tropical fruit salad.*

- 4**  **Tierra Sauvignon Blanc, Maule Valley £14.50**  
**Chile 13%** 250ml Glass **£5.00**

*Ripe blackberry aromas and a subtle underlay of oak with bright, ripe berry flavours and smooth tannins.*

- 5**  **Stonehaven Cellar Selection Riesling, £16.50**  
**Limestone Coast**  
**Australia 13%**

*Fresh and lively, exhibiting zesty lemon and lime characters, some floral notes and a dry, crisp and fruity balanced finish.*

- 19  **Duval-Leroy Fleur de Champagne, Brut Champagne** 12% **£29.00**

*A fresh, modern style with a beautiful straw gold colour and fine, blended mousse backed by a soft, rich palate with flavours of biscuits and lightly roasted nuts.*

- 20  **Piper-Heidsieck Brut Champagne** 12% **£35.00**

*Young, lively fruit flavours and a fresh, vivid aroma characterise this attractive Champagne.*

- 21  **Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut Champagne** 12% **£45.00**

*Rich and dry with great depth of flavour from this famous Reims house. Blended from a high proportion of Pinot grapes and aged for a mature, rounded character.*

- 22  **Taittinger Prestige Brut Rosé Champagne** 12% **£49.00**

*Stylish and dry with delicious summer fruit aromas and a long, full-bodied flavour. Predominantly Pinot Noir from the Montagne de Reims for a harmonious blend.*

## White Wine Cont'd

- 6  **Robert Mondavi Twin Oaks Chardonnay, California USA** 13.5% **£18.50**

*A zesty combination of citrus ripeness and hints of mangos with peaches and an elegant lingering finish.*

- 7  **Chablis, Paul Deloux France** 12% **£20.50**

*Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis.*

## Rosé Wine

- 8  **Hardys 'The Riddle' Cabernet-Grenache, SE Australia Australia** 11% **£13.75**

*Aromas of ripe strawberry with floral, rose petal overtones. Light-bodied on the palate, with soft, sweet berry fruit flavours.*

*A brief time with juice and skin together gives this delicate colour, delicious strawberry aroma and zingy freshness.*

## Red Wine

- 10**  **Fortant Merlot, VdP d'Oc** **£13.75**  
**France** 13%  
 250ml Glass **£4.75**  
 175ml Glass **£3.50**  
*Produced in the south of France using 'New World' techniques to produce a soft, fruity wine.*


- 11**  **Hardys 'The Riddle' Shiraz-Cabernet, SE Australia** **£13.75**  
**Australia** 13.5%  
 250ml Glass **£4.75**  
 175ml Glass **£3.50**  
*A classic Australian blend, spicy pepper, raspberry and cherry fruit of the Shiraz and the blackcurrant, capsicum and mint of the Cabernet. Lightly oaked, a soft finish with mellow tannins.*


- 12**  **Marqués de Morano Rioja Tinto** **£15.95**  
**Spain** 12%  
 250ml Glass **£5.30**  
 175ml Glass **£3.95**  
*A lighter style of fruity Rioja with just a hint of the traditional oakiness, made for early drinking.*

- 13**  **Tierra Merlot, Colchagua Valley** **£14.50**  
**Chile** 13.5%  
*Ripe blackberry aromas and a subtle underlay of oak with bright, ripe berry flavours and smooth tannins.*


- 14**  **D'istinto Primitivo, Calatrasi** **£15.95**  
**Italy** 13.5%  
*Deep colour with some mature hints. Lifted dried apricot and prune with spice and cinnamon notes. Overall balance of wine supported by light tannins and a long, powerful finish of fat, rich berry fruits.*

## Red Wine Cont'd

- 15**  **Rex Goliath Pinot Noir, California** **£17.95**  
**USA** 13.5%  
*Lush, velvety wine with red berry fruit flavours, such as cherry and raspberry, and a touch of cinnamon spice.*

- 16**  **Stonehaven 'Rat Et Bull' Cabernet-Shiraz, Wrattontully** **£20.95**  
**Australia** 13.5%  
*Complex and elegant with powerful fruit. A nose of cherry and dark chocolate backed up by rich blackcurrant and cherry flavours and a long finish of smooth mouthfilling tannins.*

## Bubbles

- 17**  **Berri Estates Cuvée Brut, SE Australia** **£16.50**  
**Australia** 12.5%  
*Soft and sparkling with a lively effervescence, a perfect combination of fruit and acidity. Approachable and easy-drinking with a good length.*

- 18**  **Codorníu Reserva Raventós Brut, Cava** **£19.50**  
**Spain** 11.5%  
*Prestigious cuvée Cava from the world's largest producer of sparkling wine. Made from mostly Chardonnay with a little of the local grape varieties to add complexity and style.*
