## Whites.....

- 1 **Cullinan View Chenin Blanc, Robertson, South Africa (Off dry)**  
Juicy, fruit driven and ripe  
  
South Africa's most popular grape variety. Light and fresh, but quite full, creamy and round, with a peachy fruit flavour. Very well balanced. 175ml Glass £3.95  
250ml Glass £5.55  
Bottle £16.75
- 2 **Pinot Grigio Provincia di Pavia, Italy (Very dry)**  
Very dry, delicate and subtle  
  
Lovely buttery style with typical pear fruit from this area of central northern Italy in the southern section of Lombardy. The grapes are then fermented in stainless steel tank with a long fermentation to enhance its rich style. 175ml Glass £3.95  
250ml Glass £5.55  
Bottle £16.75
- 3 **R&R Rivaner-Reisling Nahe, Pamina Cellars, Germany (Medium)**  
Refreshing and racy  
  
An exciting blend using Germany's most widely planted variety, Rivanier blended with the noble Reisling. Cool fermented in stainless steel. 175ml Glass £3.95  
250ml Glass £5.65  
Bottle £16.95
- 4 **Tierra Sauvignon Blanc, Maule Valley, Chile (Very dry)**  
Dry and herbaceous  
  
Pale yellow with olive green tones, this wine displays fresh fruit, citrus and mineral notes. The palate is zesty with good fruit ripeness, but still fresh and clean. 175ml Glass £4.25  
250ml Glass £5.75  
Bottle £16.95
- 5 **Casa La Joya Estate Reserve Viognier, Colchagua Valley, Chile (Dry)**  
Dry and aromatic  
  
Hand harvested viognier grapes are gently pressed prior to a cool fermentation. Fresh apricot and custard apple aromas with creamy notes. Well-rounded and balanced palate with aromatic fruit flavours. Bottle £20.95
- 6 **Fish Hoek Chenin Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa (Dry)**  
Juicy, fruit driven and ripe  
  
A burst of tropical fruit and melon aromas are supported on the palate with a lively acidity and a dry finish. Unoaked this is a great wine with no pretensions of grandeur. Bottle £23.75
- 7 **Drylands Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand (Dry)**  
Dry and herbaceous  
  
After the fermentation the wine is aged on its "lees" for several weeks to develop further complexity. Ripe, rich herbal and tropical fruit flavours combine in a vibrant burst of flavour on the palate. Bottle £26.00
- 8 **Chablis, Paul Deloux, France (Very dry)**  
Very dry, delicate and subtle  
  
Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis. Bottle £26.50
- 9 **Sancerre Chateau de Sancerre, Marnier Lapostolle, France (Very dry)**  
Dry and herbaceous  
  
This chateau occupies an imposing position above the steeply sloping vineyards, which surround the hilltop town of Sancerre. It produces a wine of exceptional quality and intensity. Bottle £33.50
- 10 **Pouilly-Loche Chateau de Loche, Louis Jadot, France (Dry)**  
Full flavoured, nutty and oaked  
  
This small domaine is located in the village of Loche that lies south east of Pouilly and with its own appellation. Fermented in stainless steel and then transferred to barrel for further ageing 12 months before bottling. Bottle £35.00
- 11 **Cloudy Bay Chardonnay, Marlborough, New Zealand (Dry)**  
Dry and aromatic  
  
A stylish, elegant chardonnay made using fruit from the Wairau and Brancott valleys as well as Renwick. An elegant refined palate with a ripe, creamy texture backed by good acidity and subtle oak on the finish. Bottle £48.95

## Reds.....

- 12 **Cabernet del Veneto, Collezione Marchesini**  
Light, simple and delicate  
  
A wine made using cabernet grapes from the veneto specially selected by winemaker Massimo Marasso. Classic blackcurrant flavours and smooth finish. 175ml Glass £3.75  
250ml Glass £5.35  
Bottle £16.25
- 13 **Hardys Riddle Shiraz**  
Spicy and peppery  
  
This classic Australian blend of Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits the spicy pepper, raspberry and cherry fruit of the Shiraz and the blackcurrant, capsicum and mint of the Cabernet Sauvignon. 175ml Glass £4.00  
250ml Glass £5.95  
Bottle £16.95
- 14 **Tierra Merlot, Maule Valley, Chile (Medium)**  
Juicy and fruit led  
  
Velvety ruby red in colour, exhibits ripe blackberry aromas spiced with black pepper and a subtle underlay of oak. Bright, ripe berry flavours accompanied by smooth tannins. 175ml Glass £4.05  
250ml Glass £5.80  
Bottle £17.50
- 15 **Marqués de Morano Rioja Tinto, Spain (Medium)**  
Light, simple and delicate  
  
A young lighter style of fruity Rioja with just a hint of the traditional oakiness, made for early drinking from the classic Tempranillo grape. Matured for only a short time in oak prior to bottling. Bottle £17.95
- 16 **Fish Hoek Pinotage, Western Cape, South Africa (Medium)**  
Juicy and fruit led  
  
Smoky, spicy mulberry fruit greets the nose, the palate is deliciously juicy with a typical Pinotage smoky and dried fruit character appearing. Bottle £19.95

- 17 **D'istinto Primitivo, Calatrasi, Italy (Full bodied)**  
Spicy, peppery and warming  
  
Made using 97.5% Primitivo and 2.5% Merlot. Lifted dried apricot and prune with spice and cinnamon notes. Light tannins and a long, powerful finish of fat, rich berry fruits. Bottle £21.95
  - 18 **Tintara Horseshoe Row Cabernet Sauvignon, South Australia (Full bodied)**  
Juicy and fruit led  
  
A small percentage of both Shiraz and Petit Verdot are included in this blend. Elegant with ripe tannins, blackcurrant and blackberry fruit with subtle notes of cashew nuts on the finish. Bottle £23.50
  - 19 **Cabernet Sauvignon Umbria L'Aristocratico, Marche, Italy (Medium)**  
Oaked and intense  
  
A top quality cabernet sauvignon selected from premium vineyards in the beautiful Umbrian countryside. A long maceration on the skin enables the maximum of colour and flavour to be extracted. Bottle £23.95
  - 20 **Beaujolais-Villages Combe aux Jacques, Louis Jadot, France (Med light)**  
Light, simple and delicate  
  
Intensely fragrant and vivacious, a succulent wine of exceptional charm. Full of bright, floral fruit flavours, with youthful, peppery notes and plump tannins. Great served lightly chilled. Bottle £27.50
  - 21 **Veramonte Reserva Pinot Noir, Casablanca Valley, Chile (Medium)**  
Juicy and fruit led  
  
The cool Casablanca valley is gaining a great reputation for Pinot Noir. The climate is ideal for this notoriously difficult grape to grow. Bright cherry and strawberry flavours with a rich velvety finish. Bottle £27.95
  - 22 **Barolo Siglati, Sant Orsola, Italy (Full bodied)**  
Oaked and intense  
  
Barolo rates as one of the world's greatest wines. Made from the Nebbiolo grape and grown in this small delimited area then aged for 2 years in large oak barrels. Bottle £32.95
  - 23 **Portia, Ribera del Duero, Spain (Full bodied)**  
Oaked and intense  
  
Made from 100% tempranillo, this dark inky purple and garnet coloured wine is quick to show its intensity. It has rich, ripe cherry and blackberry nose with a touch of spice and a beautifully well-balanced palate with a long finish. Bottle £35.00
  - 24 **Chateaufort de Pape, Caves Saint Pierre, Rhone, France (Full bodied)**  
Oaked and intense  
  
An excellent example of this famous southern Rhone appellation. Made using a blend of Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre and Counoise. Full bodied yet smooth and rounded. Bottle £39.95
- ## Pinks.....
- 25 **Cullinan View Chenin Blanc Rose, Robertson, South Africa (Medium)**  
Fruity and delicious  
  
The Chenin Blanc is one of South Africa's most celebrated grape varieties and now is available in this gorgeous rose wine. The wine is vibrant with fruity character with a fresh, punchy acidity and is excellently balanced. 175ml Glass £3.90  
250ml Glass £5.60  
Bottle £16.80
  - 26 **Pinot Grigio Rosato del Veneto, Italy (Dry)**  
Fruity and subtle  
  
Pinot Grigio is neither dark or light skinned as such it lends itself well to the production of pink wines. Just off dry with delicious peach and strawberry flavours. 175ml Glass £4.10  
250ml Glass £5.80  
Bottle £17.50
  - 27 **Vendange White Zinfandel, California, USA (Medium sweet)**  
Fruity and sweet  
  
Made using the Zinfandel grape from the North Central Valley. This is a beautiful salmon-pink, off-dry rosé with attractive strawberry aromas on the palate and a fresh zingy acidity. Bottle £19.50
- ## Bubbles.....
- 28 **Pinot Grigio Cuvee Brut, Sant Orsola, Italy**  
  
A refreshing sparkling version of Italy's most popular grape. Bottle £19.95
  - 29 **Codorní Selección Raventós Brut, Cava, Spain**  
  
Made from mostly Chardonnay with a little of the local grape varieties to add complexity. The grapes are grown high in the coastal mountains to maximise the grapes' complexity and balancing acidity. Bottle £21.50
  - 30 **Duval-Leroy Fleur de Champagne, Brut, France**  
  
A fresh, modern style Champagne with a beautiful straw gold colour and fine, blended mousse backed by a soft, rich palate with flavours of biscuits and lightly roasted nuts. Bottle £33.50
  - 31 **Piper-Heidsieck Brut, France**  
  
Vivacious and flowery on the nose, crisp and dry on the palate. Young, lively fruit flavours and fresh, vivid aroma characterise this attractive Champagne, long the favourite of royal courts in Europe. Bottle £39.95
  - 32 **Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut, France**  
  
A Champagne which reflects the traditions of the past, this is full, dry and rich in style and has creamy, biscuity flavours. It is the epitome of quality Champagne. Bottle £51.50
  - 33 **Taittinger Prestige Brut Rosé, France**  
  
A stylish dry rosé Champagne with delicious summer fruits aromas and a long, full-bodied flavour. Bottle £56.75
  - 34 **Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut, France**  
  
Delicate blue-pink rosé, thanks to a brief encounter with the grape skins - flowery, fragrant and dry. This rosé Champagne is rich and complex with a soft, fruit flavour. Superb, from one of the biggest Champagne houses. Bottle £65.00
