<b>1</b>	<b>Hardys 'The Riddle' Chardonnay-Semillon, South Australia (Dry)</b> Juicy, fruit driven and ripe		
	A popular blend of Chardonnay and Semillon, combining a soft, creamy texture with limey flavours and subtle oak influence. This wine has a creamy mouthfeel with a crisp dry finish.	175ml Glass 250ml Glass Bottle	£3.80 £5.20 £15.50
<b>2</b>	<b>Pinot Grigio Provincia di Pavia, Italy (Very dry)</b> Very dry, delicate and subtle

<b>4</b>	<b>Tierra Sauvignon Blanc, Maule Valley, Chile (Very dry)</b> Dry and herbaceous

<b>5</b>	<b>Casa La Joya Estate Reserve Viognier, Colchagua Valley, Chile (Dry)</b> Dry and aromatic		
	Hand harvested viognier grapes are gently pressed prior to a cool fermentation. Fresh apricot and custard apple aromas with creamy notes. Well-rounded and balanced palate with aromatic fruit flavours.	Bottle	£16.50
<b>6</b>	<b>Fish Hoek Chenin Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa (Dry)</b> Juicy, fruit driven and ripe		
	A burst of tropical fruit and melon aromas are supported on the palate with a lively acidity and a dry finish. Unoaked this is a great wine with no pretensions of grandeur.	Bottle	£18.50
<b>7</b>	<b>Robert Mondavi Twin Oaks Chardonnay, California, USA (Dry)</b> Juicy, fruit driven and ripe		
	Fermented in stainless steel for added freshness and then matured in a combination of French and American oak, the wine shows attractive and elegant aromas with some tropical notes.	Bottle	£20.00
<b>8</b>	<b>Chablis, Paul Deloux, France (Very dry)</b> Very dry, delicate and subtle		
	Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis.	Bottle	£25.00
<b>9</b>	<b>Pouilly-Loche Chateau de Loche, Louis Jadot (Dry)</b> Full flavoured, nutty and oaked		
	This small domaine is located in the village of Loche that lies south east of Pouilly and with its own appellation. Fermented in stainless steel and then transferred to barrel for further ageing 12 months before bottling.	Bottle	£35.00

<b>10</b>	<b>Hardys 'The Riddle' Shiraz-Cabernet, South Australia (Medium)</b> Spicy and peppery		
	This classic Australian blend of Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits the spicy pepper, raspberry and cherry fruit of the Shiraz and the blackcurrant, capsicum and mint of the Cabernet Sauvignon. <b>13</b>	<b>Fish Hoek Pinotage, Western Cape, South Africa (Medium)</b> Juicy and fruit led		
	Smoky, spicy mulberry fruit greets the nose, the palate is deliciously juicy with a typical Pinotage smoky and dried fruit character appearing.	Bottle	£17.50
<b>14</b>	<b>D'istinto Primitivo, Calatrasi, Italy (Full bodied)</b> Spicy, peppery and warming		
	Made using 97.5% Primitivo and 2.5% Merlot. Lifted dried apricot and prune with spice and cinnamon notes. Light tannins and a long, powerful finish of fat, rich berry fruits.	Bottle	£20.50
<b>15</b>	<b>Tintara Horseshoe Row Cabernet Sauvignon, South Australia (Full bodied)</b> Juicy and fruit led		
	A small percentage of both Shiraz and Petit Verdot are included in this blend. Elegant with ripe tannins, blackcurrant and blackberry fruit with subtle notes of cashew nuts on the finish.	Bottle	£21.00
<b>16</b>	<b>Beaujolais-Villages Combe aux Jacques, Louis Jadot, France (Med light)</b> Light, simple and delicate		
	Intensely fragrant and vivacious, a succulent wine of exceptional charm. Full of bright, floral fruit flavours, with youthful, peppery notes and plump tannins. Great served lightly chilled.	Bottle	£23.50
<b>17</b>	<b>Veramonte Reserva Pinot Noir, Casablanca Valley, Chile (Medium)</b> Juicy and fruit led		
	The cool Casablanca valley is gaining a great reputation for Pinot Noir. The climate is ideal for this notoriously difficult grape to grow. Bright cherry and strawberry flavours with a rich velvety finish.	Bottle	£25.00
<b>18</b>	<b>Barolo Siglati, Sant Orsola, Italy (Full bodied)</b> Oaked and intense		
	Barola rates as one of the world's greatest wines. Made from the Nebbiolo grape and grown in this small delimited area then aged for 2 years in large oak barrels.	Bottle	£32.50

	Made from mostly Chardonnay with a little of the local grape varieties to add complexity. The grapes are grown high in the coastal mountains to maximise the grapes' complexity and balancing acidity.	Bottle	£21.00
<b>23</b>	<b>Denbies White-downs Cuvée, England</b>		
	A delicate and refined English fizz, showing spiced elderflower notes	Bottle	£27.50
<b>24</b>	<b>Duval-Leroy Fleur de Champagne, Brut, France</b>		
	A fresh, modern style Champagne with a beautiful straw gold colour and fine, blended mousse backed by a soft, rich palate with flavours of biscuits and lightly roasted nuts. The blend, 75% Pinot Noir and 25% Chardonnay, is matured for 3 years in bottle before release.	Bottle	£32.50
